The proposed Action Taken Report (ATR) was reviewed by the faculty members of the department and it was resolved to approve the Action Taken Report.



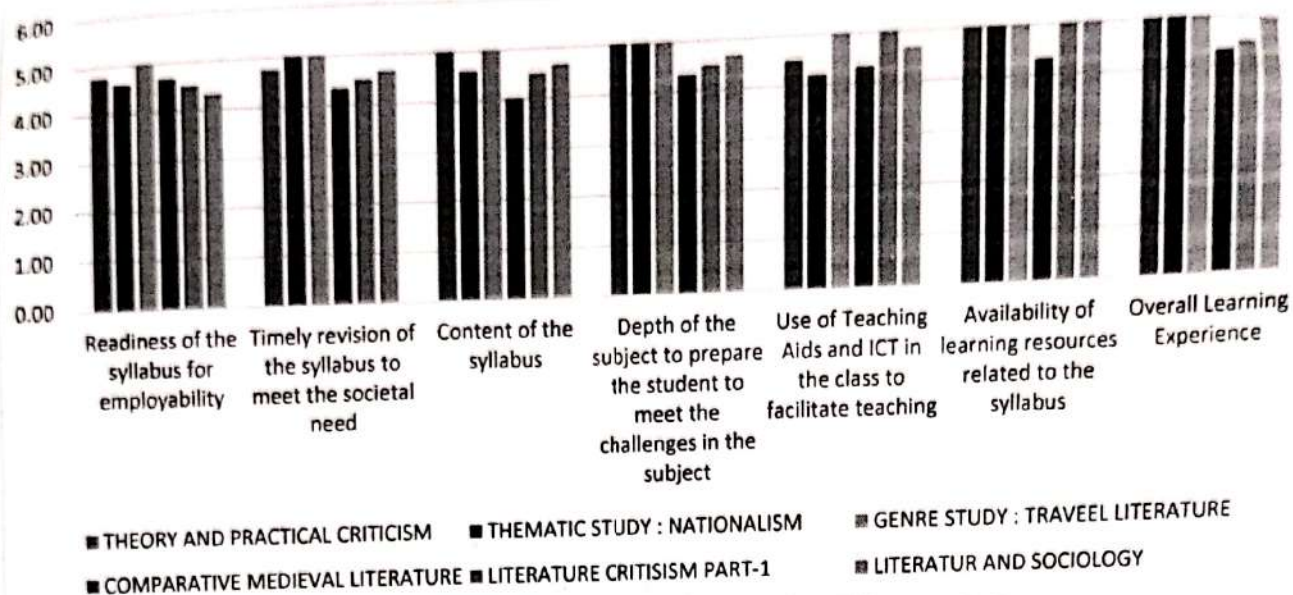
