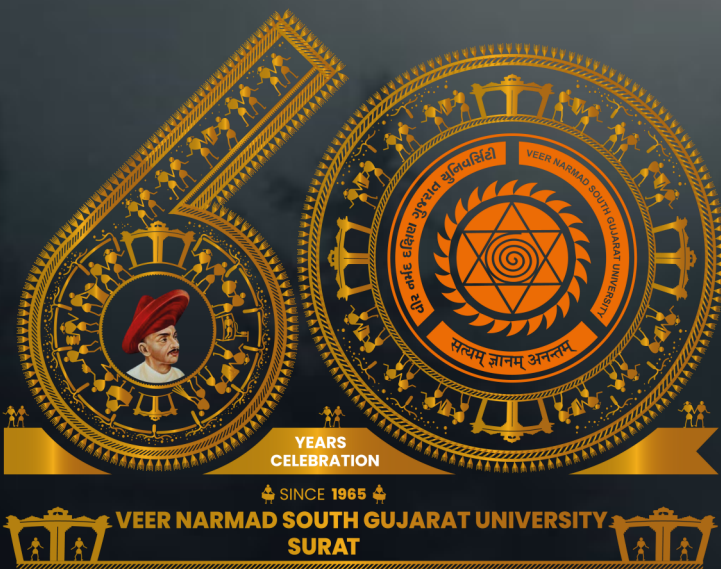

About University

The idea of a separate university for South Gujarat had its origins in the voices of visionary educationists like Atisukhshankar Trivedi. Through their impassioned public speeches and writings, they raised awareness and garnered widespread support for this endeavor. The Surat and Navsari Education societies, which had been instrumental in managing colleges offering a wide array of undergraduate and postgraduate programs, strongly backed this cause. These institutions had earned a stellar reputation under both the University of Bombay and the Gujarat University.

The pivotal moment arrived on July 31, 1960, when a meeting of educationists and prominent citizens convened under the Sarvajanik Education Society in Surat. At this gathering, a committee consisting of 38 members was appointed to formulate the guidelines and principles for the establishment of a distinct university for South Gujarat. This committee's comprehensive document was subsequently submitted to the Chief Minister and Education Minister of Gujarat.

In December 1960, during a visit to Surat, Dr. C. D. Deshmukh, then chairperson of the University Grants Commission, received the same document. In February 1961, a submission titled "South Gujarat University: A Tentative Phased Programmed for its Establishment and Development" was presented to the Education Minister. Later, in August 1962, a representative committee, known as the Lalbhai Committee, was formed to articulate the imperative, feasibility, and urgency of a separate university for South Gujarat to the Education Minister. Shri L. R. Desai, Vice-Chancellor of Gujarat University, chaired this committee.

These concerted efforts bore fruit when the Gujarat government, in principle, accepted the idea in 1964. A ten-member study team was then constituted to examine the proposal from all angles comprehensively. The recommendations of this committee included not only general suggestions for the efficient organization of courses and administration but also far-sighted recommendations for specific courses of study tailored to the region's nature and development. These included Rural Studies, Microbiology, Forestry, Textile & Manmade Fibre Technology, and Petrol Technology and petrochemicals, reflecting not only academic insight but also a profound understanding of the region's economic development and occupational composition.

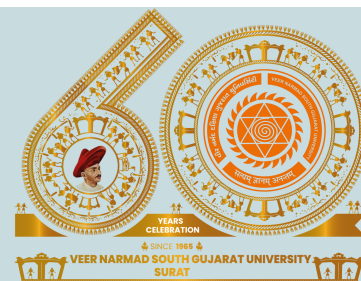
The passage of the Veer Narmad South Gujarat University Act in 1965 marked a significant milestone. In August 1966, Shri Chandravadan Chunilal Shah was appointed as the first Vice-Chancellor, and Shri Priyadatt Motiram Joshi became the first Registrar of the University. The University began its journey during the Third five-year Plan period.

Initially, a temporary office of the University commenced operations at the Sarvajanik College of Education premises in August 1966 before relocating to the Non-residential Students' Recreation Hall of Sir K. P. Commerce College in December 1966. The office gradually expanded its staff and facilities, with the first academic departments of the University becoming operational in the Fourth Plan period.

The construction of buildings on the university campus commenced during this same period. The administrative office and the Central library moved to the campus in 1976, while the teaching departments transitioned to the campus between 1977 and 1981.

As we celebrate six decades of VNSGU's existence, it is a testament to the vision, dedication, and unwavering commitment of all those who contributed to its establishment and growth. VNSGU continues to be a beacon of education and progress in South Gujarat, enriching the lives of countless students and contributing to the development of the region.

Veer Narmad South Gujarat University Founded in 1965, Veer Narmad South Gujarat University (VNSGU) has been at the forefront of higher education, dedicated to the inclusive development of the region and the nation. With a vision deeply rooted in nation-building, VNSGU strives to provide trained professionals across diverse fields of knowledge. Over six decades, the university has maintained its commitment to high standards in both undergraduate and postgraduate education, fostering research and extending its outreach to all segments of society. Evolution and Accreditation initially established under the South Gujarat University Act 1965, VNSGU became operational in the academic year 1966 and was incorporated as a university on 23 May 1967. Recognized by the University Grants Commission in 1968, it was renamed Veer Narmad South Gujarat University in 2004, honoring the great Gujarati poet Narmadshankar Lalshankar Dave. In 2017, the university received an 'A' grade with a 3.02 CGPA and was re-accredited with a 'B ++' grade and a 2.86 CGPA on a 4-point scale by the National Accreditation and Assessment Council in 2022. This recognition reflects the university's unwavering commitment to academic excellence. Mission and Objectives The core objectives of VNSGU, as envisioned by the University Act, encompass: We are delivering high-quality undergraduate and postgraduate education, culminating in the awarding of degrees to successful candidates. It is promoting research and extension activities that align with the region's needs and contribute to the broader goal of nation-building. Academic Prowess VNSGU's academic landscape extends across seven districts - Surat, Navsari, Valsad, Narmada, Dangs, Bharuch, and Tapi - along with the Union Territory of Daman and Dadra and Nagar Haveli. The university comprises 25 Post Graduate Departments/Institutes on the main campus, offering 95 programs with multiple specializations, including 19 Ph.D. programs. Additionally, VNSGU supervises 34 Government, 59 Grant-in-aid, and 190 Self-financed Colleges, along with 104 Post-graduate Teaching Centres attached to affiliated colleges. Diverse Faculties and Research With twelve faculties, spanning Arts, Commerce, Science, Education, Management Studies, Rural Studies, Engineering and Technology, Medicine, Law, Computer Science, Homeopathic, and Architecture, VNSGU fosters interdisciplinary exploration. 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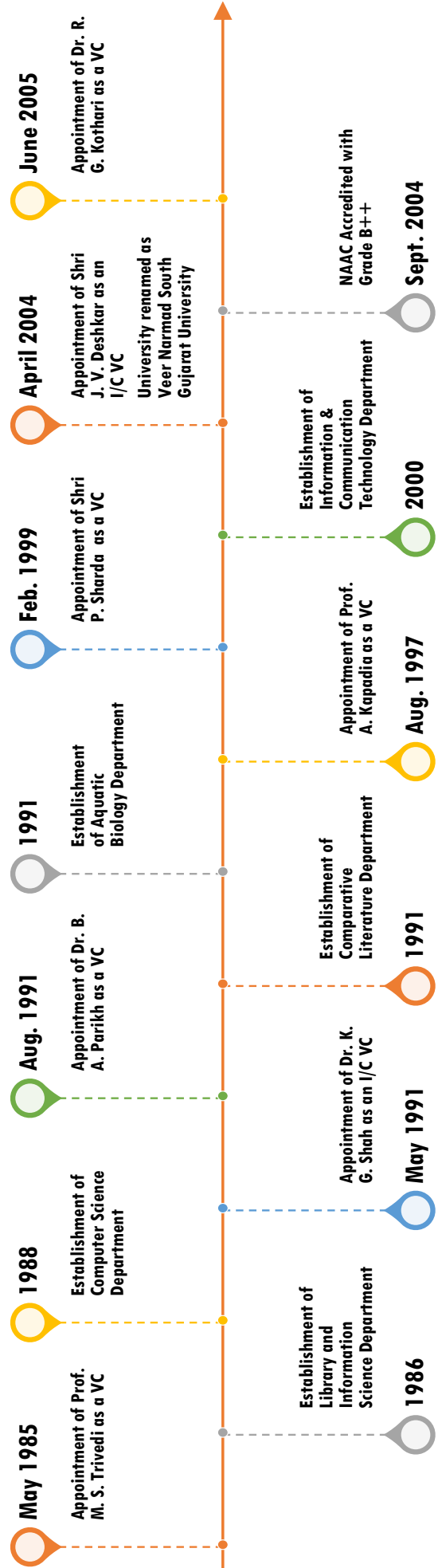


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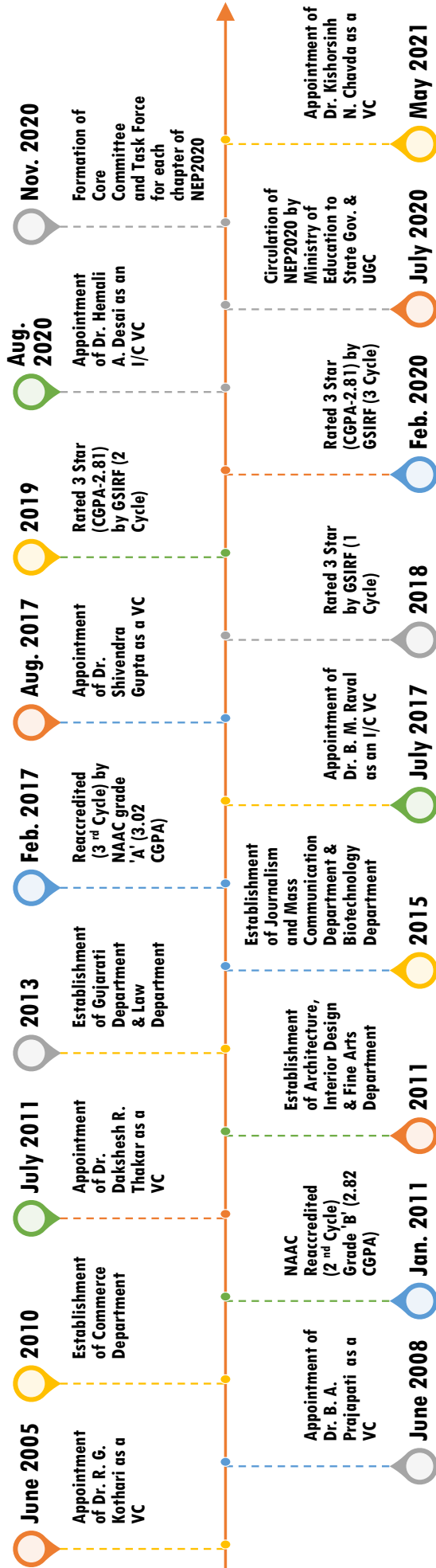




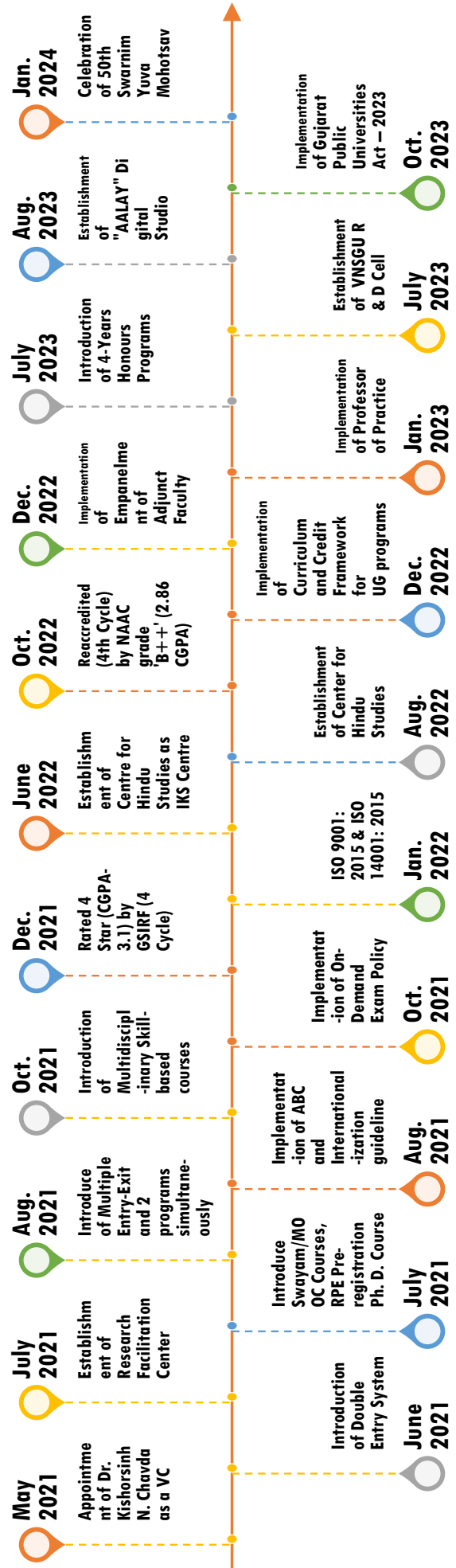
Chronology of VNSGU
