Title: Manthan-2025 – Initiative for Development of Border Villages

Preamble

"Manthan-2025" is a collective initiative aimed at the holistic development of Gujarat's border villages. It represents a platform for community dialogue and proactive engagement to foster growth in areas including education, healthcare, social awareness, economic upliftment, skill development, and employment. This campaign seeks to involve educational institutions, social organizations, and professionals in efforts to bring lasting improvements to the lives of people residing in border regions.

1. Purpose

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework of cooperation between **Seema Jagran Manch - Gujarat (SJM)** and **Veer Narmad South Gujarat University (the Institute)** for collaborative action in the development of Gujarat's international border villages through educational outreach, community empowerment, skill building, and youth engagement.

2. Scope of Collaboration

The collaboration shall focus on:

- Organizing awareness programs, workshops, and seminars on social, environmental, health, and educational themes.
 - Encouraging community engagement and youth participation in developmental initiatives.
 - Conducting outreach campaigns aligned with the objectives of both SJM and the Institute.
 - Sharing knowledge, expertise, and resources to strengthen joint efforts.
 - Promoting student and faculty involvement in village development programs.
 - Conducting biannual review meetings to evaluate progress and raise awareness of border-related issues.

3. Responsibilities of Seema Jagran Manch (SJM)

SJM agrees to:

- Provide thematic guidance for organizing workshops, seminars, and other awareness programs.
- Coordinate with local communities to facilitate outreach initiatives.
- Assist in planning and executing events focusing on social, educational, and developmental goals.

4. Responsibilities of Veer Narmad South Gujarat University

The Institute agrees to:

- Provide infrastructure support for collaborative activities.
- Mobilize student and faculty participation in joint initiatives.
- Engage with smaller educational and social institutions to extend program reach.
- Organize exposure visits to border villages, arrange community interactions, and conduct expert-led sessions for local development.
- Promote joint initiatives through internal and external communication channels.

5. Duration and Termination

- This MoU shall remain in effect for a period of [Insert Duration, e.g., Two (2) Years] from the date of signing.

7. Confidentiality

- Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of sensitive information exchanged or accessed during the course of this collaboration.

8. Dispute Resolution

- Any disputes or disagreements arising from this MoU shall be resolved amicably through mutual consultation and dialogue between the parties.
