A HISTORICAL OVERVIEW OF THE DEPARTMENT OF RURAL STUDIES

Established in 1970, the Mahatma Gandhi Department of Rural Studies inculcates diagnostic abilities in the students so as to make them competent to identify the root causes of the problems faced by rural poor. Along with this the students are made competent to provide sustainable alternatives to solve such problems. It is one of its own kind of interdisciplinary department having strong roots in learning, research and extension.

The Department

Over several decades the importance of Rural Studies as a subject in higher education is acknowledged. There is growing need of committed and trained youth to work in various fields in rural areas. These fields include experts in agriculture, natural resource management, rural entrepreneurship, NGO, rural marketing, co-operatives etc. Such trained youth are required to have in depth knowledge of socio-economic conditions of the rural areas along with a strong diagnostic ability to identify the factors inhibiting development of the area. Revival of the Panchayati Raj institutions, changing socio-economic condition after adopting new economic policies, provisions in Company Act, 2013 for Corporate Social Responsibilities and overall changes in the aspirations of rural population has further enhanced the need for trained and committed youth to work in rural areas. In light of the mandatory provisions under the Company Act, 2013 for Corporate Social Responsibilities enumerated in Schedule VII, our Department is most appropriate for providing trained, dedicated personnel who have basic understanding of problems of Rural areas and can provide sustainable solutions for the same.

What we do

An interdisciplinary approach in training the youth was adopted at the Mahatma Gandhi Department of Rural Studies where in a diagnostic ability is inculcated through field visits and experienced based programmes. They are also taught to develop micro plan for solving the problems faced by the rural population. The Department offers a two year full time Post-Graduate Programme leading to Masters of Rural Studies. The curriculum of the Course is mainly classified in Social science based papers and Natural science related papers. A detailed syllabus is provided herewith as Annexure I. Apart from the trained and experienced regular faculty, the Department invites rural development experts, executives of the Corporate and Government official to get benefit of their experience and practical knowledge. For research and extension activities

department collaborates with Government and non-Government organizations of State and the Union and the Corporate Sectors located in the area.

Research, Extension and Consultancy

The department is also actively engaged in research and extension activities concerning rural studies. Till date it has completed more than 50 projects of major and minor scale extending the period of 3 months to 5 years and involving the project value ranging from Rs.5,000 to Rs. 40,00,000. These Projects are sponsored and collaborated by various agencies like ICSSR, UGC, Department of Rural Development, Government of India and Department of Rural Development, Government of Gujarat. It had also worked for National Institutions like NIRD, IRMA, IGDRI, Planning Commission, State Rural Development Commission and Tribal Development Commission etc. and professional organizations like Indian Institute of Public Opinion (IIPO) and Center for Media studies (CMS), Delhi. It has also undertaken collaborative projects with National and International Organizations such as Indira Gandhi Development Research (IGDRI), Mumbai and East- West Center, USA and Department of Forest under OFCD Aided IFDP programme. Recently, the Department of Rural Studies has been assigned some of the prestigious assignments by Union Ministry of Rural Development such as District level **Monitoring of Rural Development** programmes and **evaluation of watershed projects** in Gujarat. NABARD had also assigned the IInd evaluation of prestigious projects of Comprehensive Tribal Development funded by International agency **KFW Germany**. Government of Gujarat had chosen us to prepare the Rural **Artisan Census** of selected districts of Gujarat. The Department had prepared a **baseline survey** and based on it prepared a **development plan** for GIPCL, Nani Naroli, Surat for its CSR activities.

The department of rural studies have received due recognition by Government of India, State Government and Rural Development related organizations as professionally competent organization. The department had initiated SAMPURNA GRAM VIKAS YOJNA in five villages as a part of Action/Research Project with UGC field study support grants.

In January-February 2010 the department had successfully carried out observations and field visits of all villages of a taluka in Surat district and three talukas of Navsari district regarding implementation and **Social Audit of MGNREGA**. This assignment was given by the Gujarat Government. Recently in April 2014 the Department prepared a **Social Audit** report for the Gujarat Industries Power Companies Limited (GIPCL) on its **Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR)** activities that it carried out through Development Efforts for Rural Economy and People (DEEP).

As an outcome of the extensive research carried out by faculty the department has published more than 400 research papers in international national and regional journals. It has also published 22 books covering different aspects of rural studies.

Faculty members of the Department had the honor to be members in experts' working group of Planning Commission of India, Planning Commission, National Commission on Rural Labour, CAPART, Ministry of Rural Development, State Department of Rural Development, DRDA, Department of Environment and Forest and Gujarat Energy Development Agency (GEDA), State Commission on Agriculture; State Review Mission of Total Sanitation Campaign and Standing Committee of UGC. We had also SBI chair, Professorship for tenure of 5 years.

The department had organized a number of National and Regional level seminars with the assistance of U.G.C, Ministry of Rural Development and Gandhian Study Centre sponsored by UGC. The department had invited Indian Society of Co-operative studies to hold its 18th National convention in November, 1999. It also organized a two days workshop on "Environmental status, issues and techno-economic alternatives for Eco-Friendly Development in South Gujarat" in March, 2000 with the assistance of Ministry of Environment. It had organized an International session on Rural Health Scenario in the International Conference of Gynecological Society of India held in Feb.2002. It organized a workshop on the Performance and Management of Rural Development Programmes in Gujarat in 2003-04 on the basis of its involvement in monitoring for rural development. Also it had organized five days workshop on "Knowledge Building in Rural Studies" for the Teachers of Rural Studies in March-2007. Similarly workshops were organized in the department and at B.R.S. college at Bilpudi for "Sampurna Gram Vikas Yojana" in five Tribal Villages adopted under Action Research Project with U.G.C. grants. The department organized a two days Workshop on Tribals, Development and Reforms, sponsored by Department of Tribal Development during 28-29 September, 2007. It had started Action Research Project of Sampurn Gram Vikas Yojana in 5 adopted tribal villages of Valsad Takuka through UGC Field grants. Department was recognized by UGC for all India Orientation Programme in Rural development'.

Our Students

The students of our department get the jobs in diverse fields such as (a) Consultant to Rural Development Agencies of Government of Gujarat (b) Officers in Agricultural and Rural Development Department (c) Officers in RRBS and Public Sector Banks (d) Corporate Sectors engaged in Social Responsibility activities (e) Corporate sector seeking Rural Markets (f) Service sector like Information Technology, Insurance and Financial services (g) Agro- based industries (h) Khadi and Village Industrial Boards (i) Private and government extension agencies (j) Cooperatives in credit, dairy and sugar and Agro-Products sectors, Agricultural Produce Market Committees (k) NGOs / Civil societies (l) Rural development related funding agencies like CAPART, NABARD (m) Tribal development related agencies (n) Social forestry and forest departments, water management related organizations like WASMO and other rural agencies such as Ecology Commission, Gujarat State Rural Technology Institute, Gujarat Energy Development Agency and District Industrial Centres etc. Students of this department also placed with Gandhian Rural Educational Organizations including BRS colleges, B.Ed. Colleges and Research Institutes primarily engaged in Rural / Tribal issues. Recently reputed organizations like WASMO and Adani Foundation, Reliance foundation, CARE India, ATMA, AKRSP etc. had recruited many students for the post of Social Mobilizers, trainer, project officer.

Message from Former Head of the Department

The Mahatma Gandhi Department of Rural Studies, under the Faculty of Rural Studies was established in the year 1970 and today it has completed 54 years. In a way it has matured and has contributed a lot in the development of tribal rural areas of the region and the state.

I was associated with the department since 1992 when I joined the department as a Lecturer. The multidisciplinary nature of the courses offered and great varieties of students from the country and

abroad added to the uniqueness of the department. From 2007 I had the opportunity to lead the Department. During these years efforts put by the entire team of the Department and the administration of the University satisfactory changes have been brought in the course content and the courses offered along with improvement in the teaching pedagogy.

The National Education Policy, 2020 now advocates multidisciplinary education system, the department was offering it since its inception. For a long period it was the only department under the faculty of Rural Studies offering Master of Rural Studies (MRS) program. The program has undergone a variety of changes during the course of time since its inception both in the courses offered and teaching pedagogy. Earlier the program was of four Semesters which later on transformed to two years program with annual examination and then again it was brought under Semester System. Similarly the number of courses offered and the marks/credits per course also has undergone changes. To further strengthen the learning process along with theory papers fieldwork based dissertation and eight weeks internship was introduced since last two decades. The Department continuously upgrades contents in the courses and introduces new courses during its exercise of syllabus reforms. Since 2013 the MRS program was enriched by introducing courses on Climate Change and Rural Society, Sustainable Rural Development and Natural Resource Management. It also started offering specializations in Rural Development and Natural Resource Management since the year 2013.

For further enhancement of the skills the Department had introduced a 20 credit module of Participatory Rural Appraisal, a widely used technique for project development and its impact analysis. It contained four theory courses and a course on dissertation.

To train the youth for the changes brought in the society worldwide, an integrated program on Sustainable Rural Development was introduced in the year 2019. This year its first batch will go to the society after completing five years of thorough training in various aspects of Sustainable Rural Development including Social, Economic and Environment.

At the front of infrastructure, the department is housed in a separate building with open space for agricultural experiments since the year 2005. Almost all the devices useful for the teaching learning process are available at the department along with a small departmental library. A new building is coming up next to the existing to house increased number of students and faculty. The Gujarat State Government has provided grant of Rs. Four Crore to build the new building for the Department.

There is a long way to go ahead to meet the challenges in the years to come including job placement of the students and introducing newer aspirations of the society and the students. I am hopeful that the department will develop further accepting the challenges.

The Department of Rural Studies has gained Major achievements: Showcase significant research, publications, awards, and other accomplishments.
