"A young lawyer after his studies in the university where he has been taught only law in the classroom and succeeds in getting through the examination by reading notes, feels frustrated and disappointed when he enters into the profession and he has to compete with the giant in his profession who has vast experience behind them in most cases, he does not even get the proper assistance from a senior he should. However, be remembered that the junior has to learn by trial and error. He has to watch cases in courts and see how seniors conduct them. The classroom study, no doubt helps a great deal in shaping the future of a young lawyer, but the real success can only be achieved through good deed of experience and careful observation by a junior of the proceedings in the court. To achieve success in the profession, particularly when the competition is very great requires dedication and hard work coupled with ability and optimism. Sometimes a young junior when he gets brief after a long waiting goes to the court after preparing his case thoroughly, and tries to put his case with confidence gets utterly disappointed and dejected when his argument is summarily rejected by the judge. A senior lawyer by his long experience knows how to get at the relevant point at once and he understands the judge. He can at once lay his hands on books and authorities, where he can find the relevant law. The understanding of the judge is itself a part of advocacy. A judge is a human being and every judge has individual approach to a case. An experienced lawyer understands him and that understanding can be acquired by a junior only by experience and constant support."
