The Degree that will be awarded after the successful completion  
Of the one year degree course will be B.P.Ed.

**1.** Admission Eligibility :

A candidate for the degree of bachelor of physical education must have passed a Bachelor degree of this University in any faculty or any other University recognized by this University equivalent there to other condition are as follows. Any graduate with at least 45% marks

OR

Any Graduate having represented state/University in Sports/Games/Athletics.

OR

Any graduate who has secured 1<sup>st</sup> , 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Position in Inter Collegiate Sports/Games Tournament.

- 2.**
- (i) The Candidate should not be more than 30 year of age of the time of admission into the course.
  - (ii) An Unmarried woman candidates only will be admitted in the Course, she cannot marry during the course.
  - (iii) Eligible candidates have to appear for entrance test, Medical test, and personal interview. Only those candidates come under the merit list through Practical Test, Written test, personal interview and medically fit will be eligible for admission.
  - (iv) The candidates should continue to be medically fit through out the period of his/her training. Candidate failing to satisfy this Condition will be liable to be removed from the college roll at a time.

- 3.** There shall be entrance test for the admission in the B.P.Ed. Course and 100% weightage will be given to the entrance test.

Entrance test will be consist of following.

a. Physical Fitness test ( Praticals )	50 Marks
b. Specialised Game Test ( Practicals )	10 Marks
c. Written Test	20 Marks
d. Sports Achievements	20 Marks

The weightage may be follows for Sports Achievements.

a. National Level	Position	20 Marks
	Participation	10 Marks
b. All India Inter University level	Position	20 Marks
	Participation	10 Marks
c. Inter college Level	Ist Position	10 Marks
	IIInd Position	07 Marks
	IIIrd Position	05 Marks

#### **4. GENERAL RULES :**

1. A Candidate who has completed a course of study for one Academic year in affiliated college and has put in minimum 90% of attendance in theory, activity classes separately and completed teaching ability and after passing examination of this University shall be eligible to appear for B.P.Ed. degree.
2. In addition to the above provision, a candidate must fulfilled the following requirements.
  - (i) Attended Leadership Training Camp organized by the college for at least 10 days.  
OR  
Attended N.S.S. Special camp organised by the college for at least 10 days.
  - (ii) There shall be a University Examination at the end of year and Candidates have to pass Theory, Practical Skills and Teaching Ability separately.

Minimum 30% in each theory paper in the University Exam.

No Minimum percentage is prescribed for the Sessional grade in Theory.

In Practical skills the minimum agreement required will be 40%.

In Teaching Ability ( Physical Education Lessons ) the Minimum aggregate required shall be 40% and it shall be out of 100 Marks Sessional and 200 Marks for University Examination of Two lesson Sessional will count as a Result of 10 ( Teaching Ability Lessons ) of 10 marks each.

Medium of Examination will be Gujarati, Hindi or English.

**5. APPLICATION FORM :**

The application for Admission will be accepted in the prescribed form only. The candidates will have to attach with application form a certified zerox Copies of the following certificate.

- a) Passing certificate of Degree of the qualifying exam.
- b) Mark sheet of the Degree examination.
- c) Sports participation certificate.
- d) S.S.C.E., H.S.C.E. Marks sheet.
- e) School Leaving Certificate showing date of birth.
- f) Migration Certificate ( For other University )

In order to be eligible for appearing at the B.P.Ed. Examination held by the University the student should attend the course of study prescribed for the examination under the relevant ordinance to the satisfaction of the Head of the Institution.

The examination for the course will be conducted by the South Gujarat University, Surat under the rules and regulation framed by the University.

#### 7. STANDARD OF PASSING :

- a) To Pass the B.P.Ed. Examination, a candidate must obtain at least 40% marks in Practical, 50% Marks in Teaching Ability and 30% Marks in Theory separately at the University Examination.
- b) Award of classes :
  - (i) The successful candidates will be placed in the Pass class if they obtain : at least 40% or more but less than 48% of the total marks in the aggregate of all the parts of the examination taken together.
  - (ii) The successful candidates will be placed in the Second class if they obtain : at least 48 % or more but less than 60% of the total marks in the aggregate of all the parts of the examination taken together.
  - (iii) The successful candidates will be placed in the first class if they obtain : at least 60 % or more but less than 70% of the total marks in the aggregate of all the parts of the examination taken together.
  - (iv) The successful candidates in first class who obtain at least 70% or more marks in the aggregate will be declared First Class with Distinction.

**8.** WORKING DAYS :

Essential

200 days (1400 hour) inclusive of examination and admission days.

Desirable

220 days (1540 hours) inclusive of examination and admission days.

7 hours per day ( 5 hours for practical & two hours for theory ) with 6 days a week.

- 9.**
- a. Candidate who fails in the theory examination of the B.P.Ed. course may present themselves for re-examination there at a subsequent examination without attending further classes.
  - b. Candidate who fails in the practical skill examination of the B.P.Ed. course shall be allowed to re-appear in subsequent year with a special permission of the Principal, provided he attends the course for two calendar months proceeding the examination.
  - c. Candidate who fails in the teaching practice University examinations of the B.P.Ed. course shall be allowed to re-appear for teaching practice examination in subsequent year with a special permission of the principal.

Note :

This course is completely residential so, Boarding & lodging for the students is compulsory in college hostels.
