Recommended Exam Reforms for Bachelor of Physiotherapy

1. University should prepare the list of all exam going students of B. Physio in alphabetical order from all the physiotherapy colleges and equally divide and allot them to each exam center. This allotment of exam center is both for theory and practical for all exam going students.
 - (a) For First year B. Physio and Third Year B. Physio follow **alphabetical order**.
 - (b) For Second year B. Physio and Fourth Year B. Physio follow **reverse alphabetical order**.
2. University should provide **Hall ticket** for each exam going student.
3. The university should collect theory paper answer books from exam center on the same day.
4. Question papers should be demanded from **Paper Setters** in the printed form to avoid spelling mistakes.
5. **Paper Correction:** For external examiner, university should send scripts to them at their residence address in advance. So that when they come to Surat for practical exams, they will bring with them the corrected paper and return it to university immediately.
6. For paper correction remuneration should be Rs. 30=00 per script.
7. For Practical exam remuneration should be Rs. 35=00 for each examiner per candidate.
8. For Superintendent of Exam remuneration should be Rs. 500=00 for half day and Rs. 1000=00 for full day exams.
9. During Practical exams, there is plenty of work for Superintendent of Exams but the university is not providing any remuneration. Please provide remuneration for Superintendent of Exam during Practical exam also.

10. Part-time MPT course may be started for Lecturers of Physiotherapy employed in colleges of Gujarat State and priority should be given to VNSGU Lecturers having B. Physio qualification.

[1] Revision of Qualification and Experience Criteria for teaching staff of a Physiotherapy college

[A] Tutor :

Minimum B.P.T. [Bachelor of Physiotherapy] From a recognized college

[B] Lecturer :

MPT OR

BPT with Two years teaching experience

[C] Assistant Professor / Sr. Lecturer :

M.P.T. with 3 years teaching experience as a Lecturer OR

B.P.T. with 5 years teaching experience as a Lecturer

[D] Associate Professor / Reader :

M.P.T. with 3 years teaching experience as an Assistant Professor / Sr. Lecturer

[E] Professor:

M.P.T. with 3 years teaching experience as Associate Professor / Reader OR

M.P.T. with 6 years teaching experience as an Assistant Professor / Sr. Lecturer.

[F] Principal / Director :

M.P.T. with 10 years teaching experience out of which 3 years teaching experience should be as an Associate Professor / Reader OR Professor

Note :

[a] Half of the number of years of clinical experience in physiotherapy will be considered as Teaching Experience for a person with academic interest / working in Medical College can be considered for appropriate teaching post

[b] For counting experience , before MPT and after MPT both teaching experience shall be counted in counting total experience

[c] The applicant must have obtained the above mentioned qualifications from the institutions recognized by IAP. And shall be the Life /Ordinary member of IAP.

[d] All teaching staff should compulsorily engaged themselves in Clinical work

[2] PG TEACHER:

A PG teacher must have at least five years of Teaching and Clinical experience in a core subject after MPT

Notwithstanding the above clause in a case of acute shortage of qualified PG Guides , A PG teacher with three years experience in a core subject after MPT can be considered

Due to acute shortage of MPT qualified PG teachers :

[a] A person with BPT with 10 years of teaching experience in a core subject

OR

[b] A person with BPT with 20 years of clinical experience with academic interest can be considered as a PG Guide

[c] Below the rank of Assistant Professor / Sr. lecturer can not be a PG Guide

[3] Procedure for Transfer of Students from other Universities in colleges of V N S G University Surat

[a] Candidate must have 50 % of marks in 10+2 Science Examination

[b] Students can apply for transfer from other Universities [EXCEPT DEEMED UNIVERSITY] to the colleges of V N S G University, provided any vacancy exists in the 2nd ,3rd or 4th years of Bachelor of Physiotherapy

[c] After getting report of equivalency from the Dean / Chairman BOS [Physiotherapy] V N S G University will provide ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE.
