Minimum marks for passing the examination:

To pass any examination a candidates must obtain in each paper of theory and each practical/seminar where ever prescribed:

1. At least **40 %** marks in the total of sessional assessment and the University examination separately in theory and practical examination.
2. At least 50% marks of the total marks assigned for the whole examination (including sessional)

Awards of Class:

No Class will be awarded at the First B. Pharm, Second B. Pharm & Third B. Pharm.

For the award of a class at the final B. Pharm examination, the weightage of marks obtained by the candidates at the second B. Pharm and third B. Pharm shall be considered.

In the case of students directly admitted to second B. Pharm from Diploma Pharmacy stream, the award of the class at final B. Pharm examination shall be above, but these students, weightage of marks obtained at second B. pharm shall be as per the scheme of examination shown in table -VIII.

Standard for passing the examination:

To pass any examination a candidates must obtain In each of the subject separately in theory and in each practical where ever prescribed:

1. **At least 40 % marks at University external examination and also 40 % aggregate marks at university external and college internal examination.**
2. At least 50% marks of the total marks assigned for the whole examination(including sessional)
3. **Each Theory & practical shall be treated as a separate Head**

Awards of Class:

No Class will be awarded at the First B. Pharm, Second B. Pharm & Third B. Pharm.

For the award of a class at the final B. Pharm examination, the weightage of marks obtained by the candidates at the second B. Pharm and third B. Pharm shall be considered.

In the case of students directly admitted to second B. Pharm from Diploma Pharmacy stream, the award of the class at final B. Pharm examination shall be above, but these students, weightage of marks obtained at second B. pharm shall be as per the scheme of examination shown in table -VIII.

Eligibility for promotion to Bachelor of Pharmacy second, third and fourth year:

Candidates who have passed in all the papers are eligible for promotion to next higher class. Students failing in four or less papers either in theory and/or practical shall be allowed to keep terms for next higher class at his/her option.

In no academic year, the total number of papers of preceding class/classes in which student **failed shall exceed four**. In such case, he/she shall not be promoted to next higher class unless he/she clears all the papers/part of them to reduce number of uncleared papers to four or less.

Eligibility for promotion to Bachelor of Pharmacy second, third and fourth year:

Candidates who have passed in all the papers are eligible for promotion to next higher class. Students failing in four or less papers either in theory and/or practical shall be allowed to keep terms for next higher class at his/her option.

In no academic year, the total number of papers of preceding class/classes in which student **failed shall exceed four**. In such case, he/she shall not be promoted to next higher class unless he/she clears all the papers/part of them to reduce number of uncleared papers to four or less.

Exemptions:

A candidate who has secured 50% of the total in any paper at the examination may at his/her discretion may Option to be exempted from appearing at that paper at the subsequent examination and

will be declared to have passed the whole examination when he/she has passed in all the remaining papers obtaining aggregate of 50% marks.

A candidate who has once refused to avail him/her self of the exemption earned by him/her in a paper shall not be permitted to claim it on subsequent occasion. For the purpose of determining whether a candidate has obtained 50 % of the total marks in aggregate, the marks obtained by the candidate in a paper on the previous occasion entitling him/her to claim exemption in the paper at subsequent appearance would be carried forward, if he/she claims exemption on any paper.
