Semester Based M.Com Programme

(From Academic Year-2010-11)

Important notes / clarifications / rules regarding the Semester Based M. Com. Program:

1. The program will be called M. Com. Program. A student can join the program as Regular or External student
2. Duration of the program will be Four Semesters. There will be two semesters per year.
3. There will be six papers (courses) in each semester as mentioned in the Annexure-I For regular mode, per paper teaching work-load will be same as the existing work-load. i.e.4 hours per week per paper & 15 weeks per semester. In each paper weight of external and internal assessments will be 70:30.
4. In each semester three papers (courses) will be related to Commerce and other three papers (courses) will be related to the special/main/principal subject of Commerce Faculty to be opted by the student.
5. In regular mode, the option of dissertation on a topic related to the special/main/principal subject will also be available to the students. A student who will choose this option will have to study two papers (courses) of research methodology, one each in semester-I and semester-II, in lieu of the third and sixth papers (courses) of the special/main/principal subject in the semester I and II respectively. The dissertation will be in lieu of ninth and twelfth papers (courses) of the special/main/principal subject of the Sem:- III and the Sem.-IV respectively.
6. A student failing in all 6 the papers (courses) of semester-I will still be eligible for admission to semester-II.
7. A student failing in not more than six papers (courses) out of 12 papers (courses) of sem:- I and sem.-II will be eligible for admission to semester-III and semester-IV.
8. On passing all the papers (courses) of all the four semesters a student will be eligible for the award of M. Com. Degree in the respective specialization and with appropriate class/grade.
9. Continuous internal assessment rules based on attendance and tutorials /assignment/seminars/group discussion etc for a semester will be same as existing rules for a year except that instead of two internal examinations per year there will be only one internal examination per semester.
10. Passing standards, exemption rules and the rules for awarding class/grade will be same as

the existing rules of annual system.

11. Credits for passing each paper (course) in a semester will be 4. Total credits for each semester will be 24.
