**(M.ED.) Full Time**

The purpose of M.Ed. programme is to prepare learners for higher level function in education including teacher education who have a broad understanding of contemporary concerns of education like philosophical, psychological, sociological & research foundations of education along with information and communication technology, psychological testing, educational management and planning and so on so forth as delineated under the course of study below in both the semesters. The purpose is to develop an educational leader with vision.

**GENERAL ORDINANCES FOR THE DEGREE OF MASTER OF EDUCATION**

1. The examination for the degree of Master of Education (M.Ed.) shall be held under Semester system consisting of two semesters at such dates and time as the university may prescribe.
2. The examination for the degree of Master of Education (M.Ed.) shall be open to the candidate who has, (i) after graduation passed the B.Ed. or B.Ed.(special) Examination or an equivalent examination held by a State Government or by any University in India recognized by law of the place in which it is situated or of any University or body which the Academic Council may from time to time recognize for this purpose with at least 50% marks in Theory, and (ii) persued for one session (two semesters) the prescribed course of study in the University or satisfies the conditions laid down as here below.
3. The examination for the degree of Master of Education (M.Ed.) will include Papers, Dissertation, and Field Based Experience.
4. The M.Ed. programme will consist of three parts a. b & c details of each part are given below :

**a. THEORY PAPERS**

**• Core Papers : Marks : 4\*100=400**

CBCS094177 : Philosophical and Social Foundations of Education

CBCS094277 : Advanced Educational Psychology

CBCS094377 : Methodology of Educational Research

CBCS094477 : Information and Communication Technology

**• Elective Papers : Marks : 2\*100=200**

**b. FIELD BASED EXPERIENCES : Marks=50.**

Related to supervision and evaluation of practice –teaching and other : aspects of school experiences of B.Ed. programmes **as well as seminar/workshop**

**c. DISSERTATION : Marks=150 ( Total Marks OF a.+b.+c. = 800)**

- I. Every candidate will be required to select the topic for Dissertation. and will have to work on it regularly and submit report to concerned guide.
- II. Candidates enrolled for the M. Ed. Degree examination will be. required to submit **THREE** copies of the Dissertation on or before the date of submission
- III. In final viva –voce candidate will be examined on the Dissertation.
5. Admissions to the various elective courses will be decided on the basis of availability of Papers.

**6. Mode of Evaluation :**

- I. 150 Marks of Dissertation will be distributed as follows :
  - a. Internal = 25 (Ist semester)
  - b. Thesis = 75 (IInd semester)
  - c. viva – voce =50 (IInd semester)
- II. 50 Marks of Field Based Experience will be Internal and will be distributed as follows :
  - a. Seminar/workshop = 25 (Ist semester)
  - b. Field Experience/Internship =25 (IInd semester)
- III. A record of the Internal Assessment will be maintained by the department.
- IV. 100 marks of each theory paper will be distributed as follows :
  - a. Each paper of theory at the University Examination will carry 70 marks and will be of Three hours duration.
  - b. 30 Marks of Internal assessment for each paper will be distributed as follows :

Mid term Test	: 10
Assignment or Practicum	: 08
Classroom Participation	: 06
Viva –voce	: 06

## 7. Standards of Passing

To pass the M. Ed. Degree examination a candidate must ;

- (a) Obtain at least 40% of marks in each paper in internal assessment as well as the external examination. In addition a candidate must secure in aggregate 50% of marks in the internals as well as external examination.
- (b) Obtain at least 50% of marks in Field Based Experiences.
- (c) Obtain at least 50% of the marks in dissertation both in the internal as well as at the viva-voce examination separately.
- (d) Obtain at least 50% of marks at the evaluation of study report as well as the viva-voce examination.

## 8. The System of Evaluation

The system of evaluation will be as follows: Each assignment/ test will be evaluated in terms of marks. The marks for separate assignment and the final examination will be added together and converted into a grade and later grade point average. Results will be declared for each semester and the final examination will give total marks, grades, grade point average.

If a student misses an internal assessment examination he/she will be given second chance with permission of the teacher concerned.

\_ Students who have failed and who have been absent for the entire course may reappear at the semester- end exam. Their internal marks will not change.

9. If a candidate passes in the dissertation but fails in the papers, the marks obtained by him /her in the dissertation shall be carried over to the subsequent semester or semesters Examination and he/she will be allowed to appear at the University Examination only.

If a candidate passes in the papers but fails in the dissertation the marks obtained by him /her in the papers shall be carried over to the subsequent semester Examination and he/she will be at liberty to revise and resubmit the dissertation in the subsequent semester or semesters.

Similarly the marks of viva-voce and internal Assessment etc. will be carried over to the subsequent semester or semesters.

Note : The student will be allowed to appear for maximum 06 semesters.

The description for each of the grades will be as follows:

### **Grades Proposed Norms**

**O : Outstanding** : Excellent Analysis of the topic ,Accurate knowledge of the primary material, wide range of reading, logical development of ideas, originality in approaching the subject, neat and systematic organization of content, elegant and lucid style.

**A : Very Good** : Excellent Analysis of the topic ,Accurate knowledge of the primary material, acquaintance with seminal publication, logical development of ideas, neat and systematic organization of content, effective and clear expression.

**B : Good** : Good analysis and treatment of the topic, Basic knowledge of the primary material, logical development of ideas, neat and systematic organization of content, effective and clear expression.

**C : Average** : Some important points covered basic knowledge of the primary material, logical development of ideas, neat and systematic organization of content, good language or expression.

**D : Satisfactory :** Some points discussed basic knowledge of the primary material, some organization, acceptable language or expression.

**E : Pass :** Any two of the above.

**F : Fail :** None of the above.
