

# **Veer Narmad South Gujarat University, Surat.**

## **GENERAL RULES**

1. The duration of the course shall be total 4 semesters, each semester consisting of 90 working days, exclusive of days of examination at the conclusion of semester. Normally in an academic year the First / Third semester shall be from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> November, and the Second / Fourth semester from 1<sup>st</sup> December to 30<sup>th</sup> April.

2. A candidate who ( a ) after taking a Bachelor's degree in Physical Education of this University or of an Indian University recognized by the Syndicate or ( b ) after obtaining a post-graduate Diploma in Physical Education of at least one year's duration awarded by the Education Department of a State, or ( c ) after obtaining Indian or Foreign qualification recognized as equivalent to those mentioned in ( a ) or ( b ) above by the Syndicate of this University , has completed a regular course of study for one semester shall be admitted to the First Semester examination for the degree of Master of Physical Education subject to being selected on the basis of Admission Tests prevailing in the year when admission is sought in this course.

A candidate who, after passing the First, Second and Third Semester Examinations of this University has completed a regular course of study for one semester, shall be admitted to the Second, Third and Fourth semester examination respectively, for the degree of Master of Physical Education.

However, a candidate failing in any paper or all papers shall be permitted to join the next semester, in which case he shall have to appear in the papers in which he had failed in the immediately previous semester along-with the papers for the current semester. No candidate shall be allowed to join the next semester if he has not passed in all the papers of the semester proceeding the immediately previous semester i.e. no candidate shall be admitted to the Third semester unless he has passed in all the papers of the First Semester. Similarly, no candidate shall be admitted to the Fourth Semester unless he has passed in all the papers of the Second Semester.

3. The medium of instruction shall be Gujarati.

4. The examination for Master of Physical Education shall consist of 16 Theory papers, Four papers shall be offered in each of the four semesters. Besides the University examination, internal marks will be added to each paper separately. A candidate must obtain for passing at least 45% marks in each theory paper in the University examination and also obtain at least 45% marks in the aggregate marks of the paper including the internal marks in each paper of each semester.

In First, Second and Third semester there shall be a final examination in part- II ( Instructional Activity ) and in Fourth semester a final examination of Coaching Specialization to be conducted by the Internal and external examiner and each candidate must obtain for passing at least 50% marks in this examination. M.P.E. examination part – II shall be considered to be equivalent to the theory paper .

5. The University examination in Thesis for Semester IV shall consist of the examination of the thesis by one external examiner who shall evaluate the thesis out of maximum of 70 marks. There shall be viva-voce examination of maximum of 30 marks.

6. The marks obtained by a candidate in all papers of all semesters shall count together for a place on the pass list of the final semester examination. No division shall be assigned on the result of each semester. Division for M.P.E. shall be awarded on the basis of cumulative marks in Part I and Part II ( Theory , Instructional Activity and Sport Specialization together.

7. *A candidate shall pass the final semester within 5 years from the date of the commencement of his first semester.*

8. Internal marks obtained by a candidate shall be carried over if a candidate fails in the final examination in any or all papers of any semester and appears as an ex-student. If the candidate seeks readmission as a regular student, the internal marks previously obtained for those papers shall stand cancelled.

When a candidate has failed in the examination but has obtained pass marks in the thesis, the thesis marks may be carried forward to the prescribed limits of 5 years as specified above. If candidate fails in thesis but secures pass marks in theory papers, the candidate shall be permitted to complete his requirement for thesis within the required period of 5 years. When a candidate seeks fresh assignment of thesis, his marks previously obtained shall stand cancelled. The advisor for the thesis shall be the internal examiner for the thesis.. The candidates of M.P.E. shall submit three copies of thesis before 15 days of the commencement of final examination failing which they shall be declared failed in thesis and such candidates shall have to submit the thesis in the next examination as ex student.

9. The candidates who opt for thesis, they have to submit Research proposal in 3 copies within one and half month from the commencement of the Third semester. The Research committee at college level conduct the viva-voce and approve the proposed research proposal..
