## Eligibility & Assessment Policy

### for First, Second, Third – Phase I & II MBBS

1. There will not be any provision for extra classes to compensate for absence or missing classes, as NMC has clearly stated their requirement for minimum 75% (theory) & minimum 80% (clinical posting, practical & AETCOM) must for eligibility to appear in examination. The attendance policy has been made by Attendance committee of respective colleges.
2. For University purpose, internal assessment report to be sent for eligibility will be calculated as per NMC. Annexure-1

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3. Internal assessment will be done Department wise & conducted as per NMC norms for eligibility. If student is non-eligible because of internal assessment underperformance his / her remedial measures will be conducted. Remedial Measures will be taken for students who have appeared for all Internal Assessments. If candidate fails, in even remedial exams, he will be declared non eligible for regular University Exams.
4. Remedial measures assessment pattern should be replica of preliminary/pre- university examination.
5. Internal exams if missed due to some reasons, can be reconsidered by respective Head of the Department/Dean only if he/she finds it to be valid reason and will be taken within 15 days of the date of missed exam. Such reason can be considered only for once. That means only one missed exam out all internal assessments can be taken.
6. Marks for journal and logbook which are a part of Formative assessment will be given before conducting preliminary exam, so students have to complete logbook and journal for all term and get sign of relevant faculty. This also means that students should bring the log book daily for day to day assessment reports.

7. The university will put Remedial (R) against the Internal Assessment marks in marksheet for the subject in which student became eligible after remedial measures.
  8. Supplementary exam should be conducted after declaration of result of University examinations within timeframe suggested by NMC. The result of supplementary examinations be declared within a week from the date of completion of examination. In the NMC document the eligibility for Supplementary exams has not been mentioned clearly so for University it will be conducted for those who
    - a. Fail in University exams &b. Students who were not eligible for University exams if they become eligible by scoring 50% on appearing for remedial exams again to become eligible.
- \* The "S" for supplementary exam passing will be written in their marksheets by the University.

### Summative assessment logistics (For Universities)

Summative assessment consists of University examinations. Each theory paper will have 100 marks. Marks distribution as per proposed GMER 2019 for various subjects is given in Table 2.
